was formed in May of 2010 through the partnership of

five local non-profit organizations: For The Forest, The Aspen Global Change Institute, The Community Office for Resource Efficiency, Flux Farm Foundation, and The Sopris Foundation. Together, this group applied for a woody biomass feasibility study grant from the Colorado Governor's Energy Office. The RFBC was awarded a ~ \$20,000 grant that then leveraged a ~ \$100,000 study. The Roaring Fork Regional Biomass Summit marks the completion of this study.
