

Write for CFA Forestry Journal or Web Site

To obtain material with a local orientation for use in the Forestry Journal and/or the Colorado Forestry Association web site the CFA Board Of Directors has established a policy that encourages members and students to write articles about:

- * Colorado forests (history, biology, ecology, fire ecology, silviculture, health),
- * Colorado forest industries (history, current technology, future technology, economics, new products),
- * Colorado forestry politics/policies (history, related to climate change initiatives, fire management, legislation and policies).

Encouragement will be in the form of paying CFA members or students in any Colorado institution of higher education for the use of their material in the Forestry Journal and/or the CFA web site.

A maximum of \$800/year shall be available for this purpose. Maximum payment for an article used in *either* the Journal **OR** the web site shall be \$100. Maximum payment for an article used in *both* the Journal **AND** the web site shall be \$200.

Articles shall be submitted to the CFA Editorial Board which is composed of the President, the editor of the Forestry Journal, and the web master. Said board shall evaluate appropriateness of content, literary style, grammar and supporting charts and images, before making an offer of payment, subject to the limits above, for use of the submitted work.
